WHO SHOULD ATTEND THIS PROGRAMME?

Whilst there are no formal entry requirements, participants will normally:

- Be practising senior leaders and managers
- Be strong performers in their core role
- Possess strong communication skills
- Have demonstrated an understanding of coaching and an interest in further developing their coaching skills
- Have the capacity to invest a minimum of 2-3 hours a week to the programme in addition to the structured workshops

WHAT DOES THE TRAINING INVOLVE?

The ILM7 Certificate in Executive Coaching and Leadership Mentoring is awarded to participants who successfully complete:

1. At least 45 hours guided learning across 6 days of workshops. Notion also supervises at least 3 coaching practice sessions
2. A 1,500 word work-based assignment to be submitted for assessment
3. A Coaching Diary based on a minimum of 12 hours workplace coaching including reflective review

In total this equates to a commitment of 105 hours of independent study, and an overall commitment of 150 hours to qualify.

The anticipated time investment (excluding the 6 days of workshops) is 2-3 hours a week over a 12-month period.
